

## Flowchart of COVID Rules (UPDATED 1/19/22)

### My student:

<b>Is COVID Positive</b>	Out for five days, starting on Day 0 (Date of Symptom Onset or Positive Test)
<b>Is Vaccinated and Boosted</b>	Please attend school as normal. Self-monitor for any possible developing symptoms.
<b>Had a <i>documented</i> COVID-19 Positive Case within the last 90 calendar days</b>	Please attend school as normal. Self-monitor for any possible developing symptoms.

		Come Back	Testing Requirements	Attestation Requirement
<b>Is Symptomatic (choose one option)</b>	→	Return after resolution of symptoms	One lab-confirmed rapid or PCR test from a testing location	No attestation required; Must provide copy of negative result to Health Office
	→	Return after three days with resolution of symptoms	Must complete two at-home tests in 36 hours	Attestation required
	→	Or return after five days with resolution of symptoms	No testing required	No attestation required

<b>Vaccinated and Asymptomatic</b>		Please attend school as normal. Self-monitor for any possible developing symptoms. The student cannot participate in any extracurricular activity for five days from the initial exposure if they are eligible to be boosted and have not received their booster.		
<b>Vaccinated and Symptomatic (choose one option)</b>	→	Return after resolution of symptoms	One lab-confirmed rapid or PCR test from a testing location	No attestation required; Must provide copy of negative result to Health Office
	→	Return after three days with resolution of symptoms	Must complete two at-home tests in 36 hours	Attestation required
	→	Or return after five days with resolution of symptoms	No testing required	No attestation required
