

## LEGAL NOTICE

### NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING, BUDGET VOTE AND ELECTION CAMBRIDGE CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that a public hearing of the qualified voters of the Cambridge Central School District, Washington County, Cambridge, New York, will be held at the school house in said school district on May 11, 2021, at 7:00 PM, prevailing time, for the presentation of the budget.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that the annual meeting of the qualified voters of the Cambridge Central School District, Washington County, Cambridge, New York, will be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, in the Elementary Gymnasium, 24 South Park Street, in said district, at which time said vote and election will be held between the hours of 12:00 noon and 8:00 PM, prevailing time, at which time the polls will be opened to vote by voting machine upon the following items:

1. To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2021-2022 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.
2. To elect two members of the Board of Education each for a three-year term commencing July 1, 2021, and expiring on June 30, 2024, to fill the seats presently held by Beth O'Grady and Jessica Roosevelt, whose terms expire on June 30, 2021.
3. Public Library Proposition as follows:  
Shall an appropriation of \$58,000 be made in the 2021-2022 Budget for the Cambridge Public Library; this sum to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the Cambridge Central School District?
4. Bus Lease Proposition-  
Shall the Board of Education of the Cambridge Central School District be authorized to lease three (3) school buses and expend therefore, including costs incidental thereto, an amount not to exceed the estimated maximum aggregate cost of Three-Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$331,500.00), for a term not to exceed five (5) years?

**AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required to fund the School District's budget for 2021-2022, exclusive of public monies, may be obtained on the District's website ([www.cambridgecsd.org](http://www.cambridgecsd.org)) beginning May 11, 2021.

**AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the Clerk of said School District no later than 5:00 PM, Monday April 19, 2021. Each petition shall be directed to the Clerk of the District and, must state the name and residence of the candidate, and shall describe the specific vacancy for which the candidate is nominated including the length of term of office and the name of the last incumbent.

**AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that applications for absentee ballots will be obtainable between the hours of 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM Monday through Friday, except holidays,

from the District Clerk. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m., prevailing time, on Tuesday, May 18, 2021. A list of persons to whom absentee ballots are issued will be available for inspection to qualified voters of the District in the office of the District Clerk on and after May 10, 2021, between the hours of 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM on weekdays prior the day set for the annual election and on May 18, 2021, the day set for the election, and said list will be posted at the polling place at the election. Any qualified voter present in the polling place may object to the voting of the ballot upon appropriate grounds for making his/her challenge and the reasons therefore known to the Inspector of Election before the close of the polls.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that registered military voters may apply for a military ballot by requesting a military ballot application and indicating his/her preference for receiving said military ballot application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or email, and where such application is received and approved prior to April 23, 2021, such military ballot shall be issued on or before April 23, 2021.

**AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days preceding the annual vote and election. (4) No person shall have the right to register for or vote at any school meeting or election who would not be qualified to register for or vote at an election in accordance with the provisions of Section 5-106 of the election law. The School District may require all persons offering to vote at the budget vote and election to provide one form of proof of residency pursuant to Education Law §2018-c. Such form may include a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the School District may also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.
