HOME SCREENING



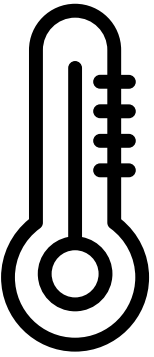
- Temperature check by parent
- Symptom check by parent
 - Fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, fatigue, diarrhea or vomiting, runny nose, body/muscle aches, headache, loss of sense of taste or smell
- Input information into the EduForm Application



Please stay home if you are sick in any way

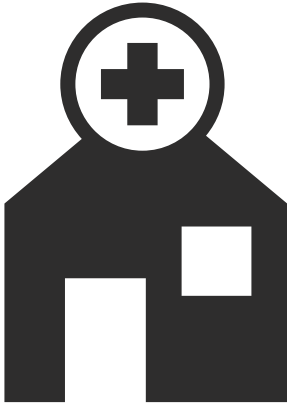
Arriving at school

TEMPERATURE SCANNING



- When students arrive at school their temperature will be taken
 - If a student presents with a temperature of 100 degrees or above they will report to a health screening room.
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Health Office Protocols



- When a student presents or expresses a health concern:
 - Staff will notify the Health Office
 - Health Office will triage and determine appropriate response
 - For physical distancing purposes there will be a limited number of students in the Health Office at any given time.
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Suspected Case of COVID-19



- Separate location established for examination
- School nurse will assess symptoms and conduct a temperature check
- School nurse will determine appropriate action
- Room will be sanitized after each use
- Return to school will follow the Washington County Department of Health guidance.

Confirmed Case of COVID-19:



- We will work directly with the Washington County Department of Health
