What is *i-Ready*?

***i-Ready* is an online program for reading and/or mathematics that will help your child's teacher(s) determine your child's needs, personalize their learning, and monitor progress throughout the school year. *i-Ready* allows your teacher(s) to meet your child exactly where they are and provides data to increase your child's learning gains. *i-Ready* consists of two parts: Diagnostic and Instruction. CCS gives the Diagnostic three (3) times per year. Parents will be given reports at Parent Conferences and in the February and June Report Cards.

i-Ready Diagnostic:

The *i-Ready Diagnostic* is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your child's needs. Each item a student sees is individualized based on their answer to the previous question. For example, a series of correct answers will result in slightly harder questions, while a series of incorrect answers will yield slightly easier questions. The purpose of this is not to give your child a score or grade, but instead to determine how best to support your child's learning.
