**Consider approval of the amended Consent Agenda as listed in the Consent Agenda for Personnel:** Recommend approval of the amended consent agenda with regard to personnel appointments and recommendations.

**G. ACTION**  
**Recommend approval of the following Resolution:**

Recommend approval of the propositions to be placed on the ballot at the Annual Budget Vote/Election to be held on May 21, 2019.

1. Public Library Proposition-Shall an appropriation of \$55,000 be made in the 2019-20 Budget for the Cambridge Public Library; this sum to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the Cambridge Central School District.
2. RESOLVED that, pursuant to Chapter 472 of the Session Laws of 1998, the Board of Education of the Cambridge Central School District is hereby authorized to lease and expend therefore, including costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof, an amount not to exceed the estimated maximum cost of Ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000), and for a term not to exceed five (5) years, the following motors vehicles: five (5) seventy (70) passenger school buses; AND, that such sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax collected in annual installments; and that in anticipation of such tax, obligations of the District shall be issued.

The Cambridge Central School Board of Education designates the area between 24 South Park Street, Cambridge, NY and 33 Gilbert Street, Cambridge, NY as a Child Safety Zone as a result of the study by the Safety Committee.
